### Gardening Club Update

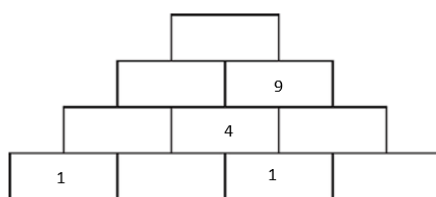

In time, we look forward to sharing the fruits of our labour with the Hayling Pantry and other organisations across the Island.

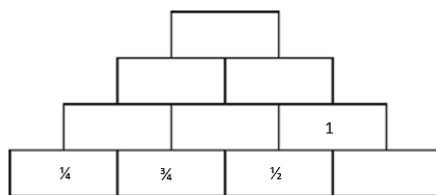
## Maths Challenge
